

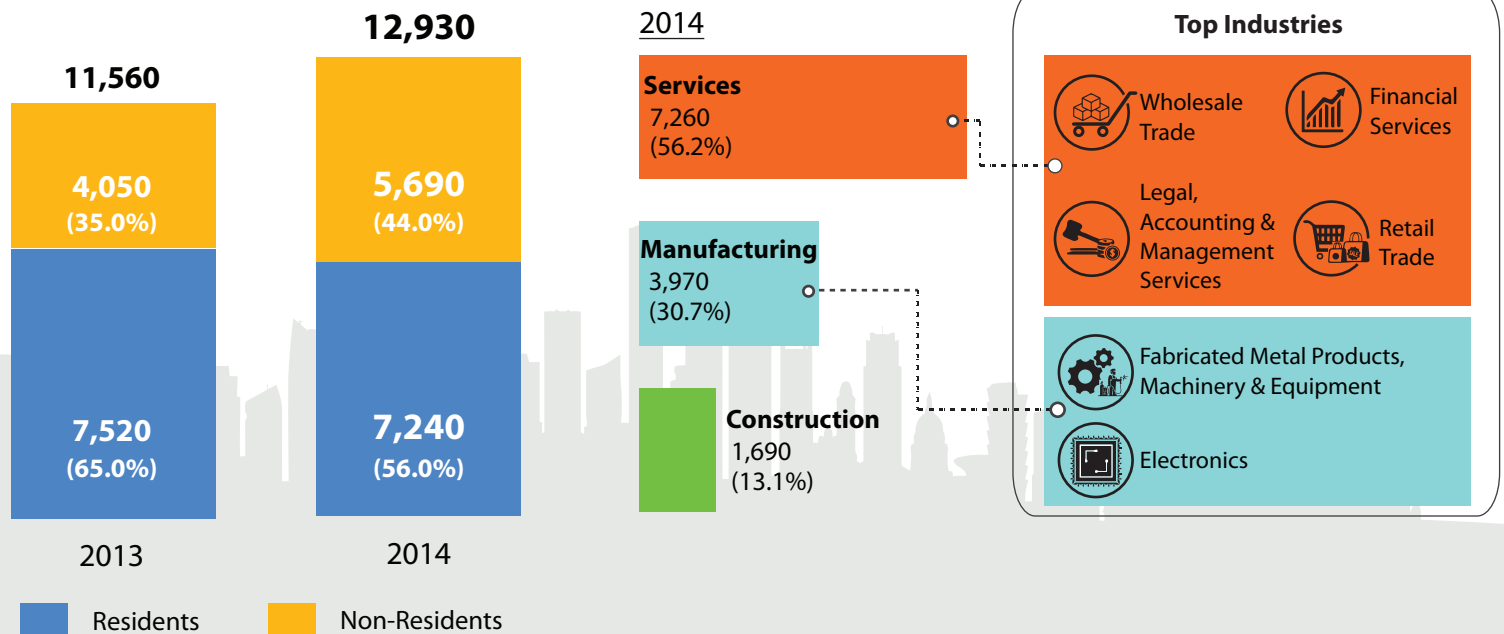
# REDUNDANCY AND

Redundancies rose as businesses restructure.

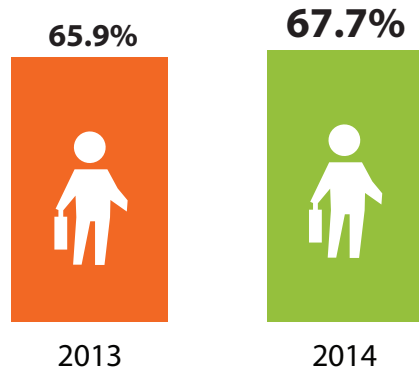
The increase came from non-residents, and mainly services industries
