

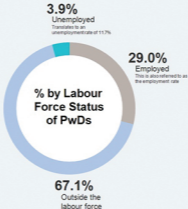


The Manpower Research and Statistics Department of the Ministry of Manpower started collecting data on the employment outcomes of Persons with Disability (PwDs) in 2018.

The information presented in this infographic was obtained from the Comprehensive Labour Force Survey, an annual sample survey of 33,000 households.

Poor health or disability were the most commonly cited reasons for being outside the labour force.
