






Migrant Worker Experience and Employer Survey 2024


Satisfaction levels for migrant workers continued to improve in 2024



Were satisfied with working and living in Singapore, the **highest level recorded since the survey began in 2011.**



Planned to continue working in Singapore or return for employment in the future.




92.3% would recommend Singapore as a place to work, up from 84.0% in 2018.


Top reasons for recommending Singapore were:



Employers had generally positive sentiments towards the migrant workforce



Expressed satisfaction with the quality of their workers.




Renewed work permits of more than 80% of their workers.

While **47.5%** reported good access to migrant workers, only **27.3%** found it easy to find workers with the needed skills, suggesting room to improve the hiring of higher-skilled workers.
