

SINGAPOREANS IN THE WORKFORCE

Singaporeans have one of the highest employment rates internationally




Nearly **8** in **10** citizens aged 25 to 64 were employed in 2010, surpassing other Asian NIEs and most advanced economies

Unemployment rate of citizens fell with strong economic recovery



Income of average Singaporean grew over the decade, even after accounting for inflation

Median income of citizens in full-time employment



The mid-year Labour Force Survey was not conducted in 2000, hence 2001 data were used instead.

Household income grew faster, as more people were employed
