






Employment rate similar to a year ago




Median gross monthly income from work (including employer CPF contributions) of full-time employed residents




Sex distribution of resident labour force

Share of females in the resident labour force rose




Age distribution of resident labour force

Labour force continued to age




Highest qualification attained of resident labour force


Duration of unemployment of unemployed residents, 2016


Occupational distribution of employed residents

Rising share of residents in PMET jobs




Full-time/part-time share of employed residents, 2016

Type of employment of resident employees, 2016




