

PERSONS OUTSIDE THE LABOUR FORCE


Incidence of residents discouraged from seeking work

Per Cent


Pool of potential entrants fell to a new low


Employment rate (Aged 25 to 64)

Employment rate continued to trend upwards




Median gross monthly income from work (including employer CPF contributions) of full-time employed residents




Sex distribution of resident labour force

Female share of the labour force rose




Age distribution of resident labour force


Duration of unemployment of unemployed residents, 2017

PMET share among employed residents rose




Full-time/part-time share of employed residents, 2017



Employment status of employed residents, 2017




Type of employment of resident employees, 2017
