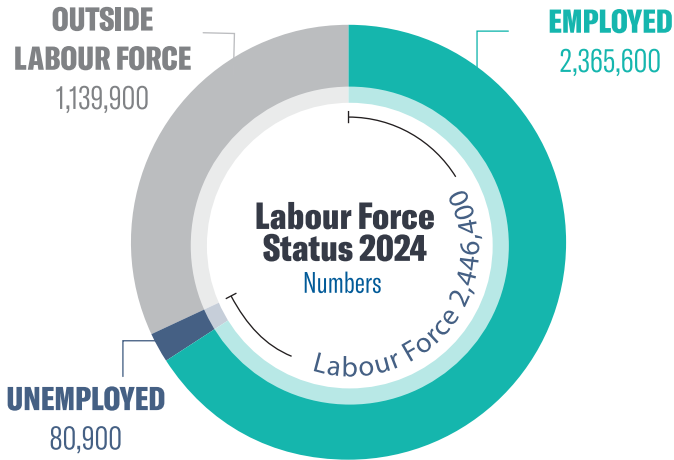


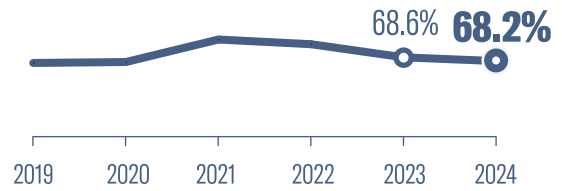

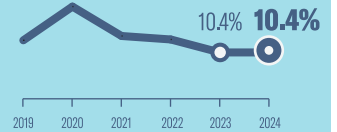
LABOUR FORCE PARTICIPATION RATE

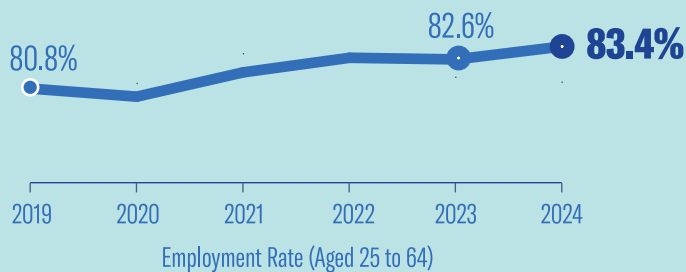
INCIDENCE OF DISCOURAGED WORKERS DECLINED FURTHER



THE SHARE OF POTENTIAL ENTRANTS REMAINED LOW

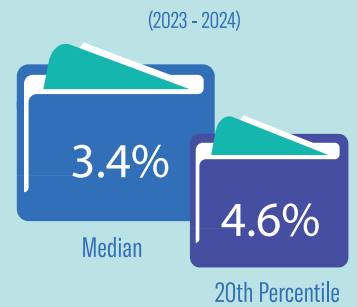

Income including employer CPF contributions of full-time employed residents

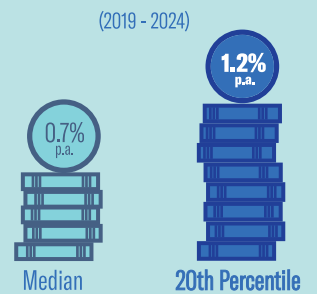


TIME-RELATED UNDER-EMPLOYMENT RATE

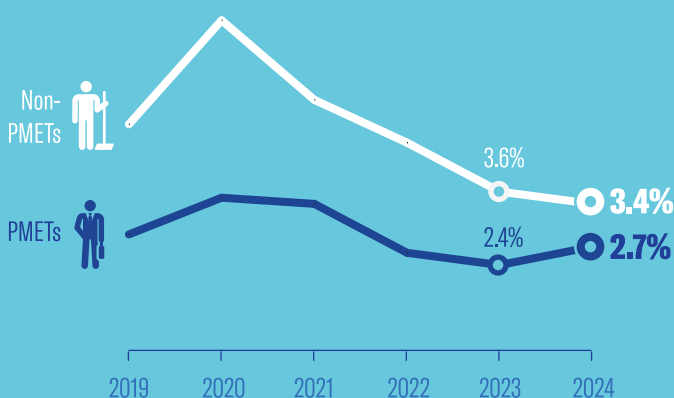


REAL INCOME GROWTH AT 20TH PERCENTILE OUTPACED THE MEDIAN OVER THE LONGER TERM



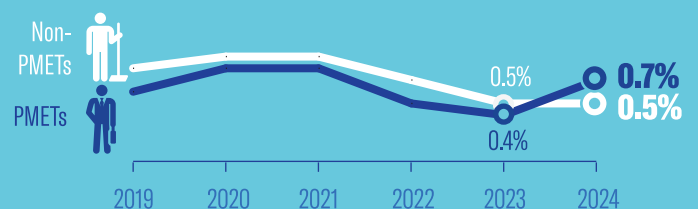
UNEMPLOYMENT RATES

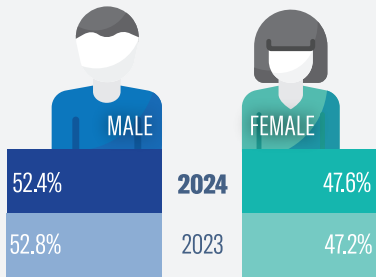

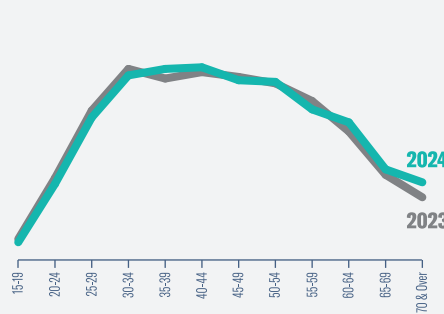

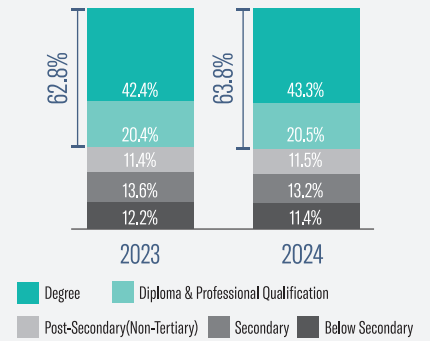
DISTRIBUTION BY SEX



DISTRIBUTION BY AGE

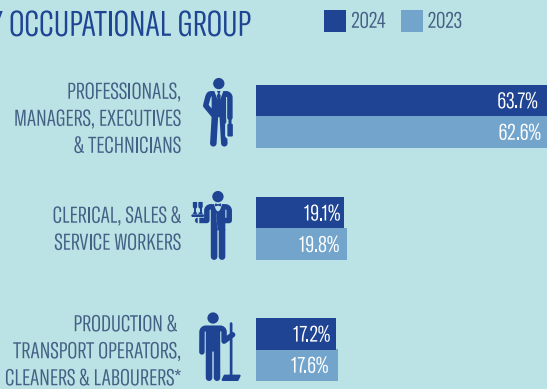


DISTRIBUTION BY HIGHEST QUALIFICATION ATTAINED

BY OCCUPATIONAL GROUP

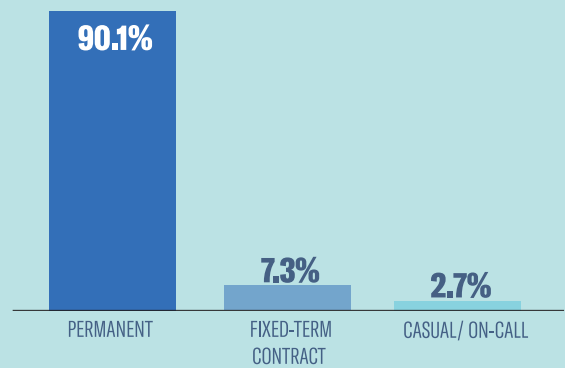

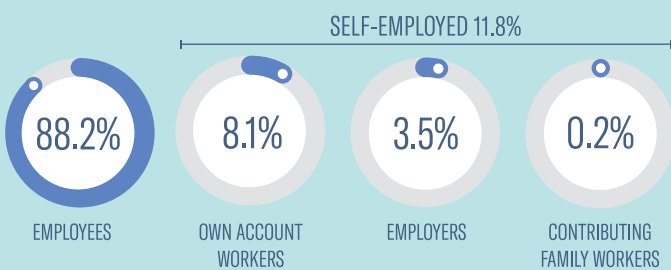
BY NATURE OF EMPLOYMENT, 2024
