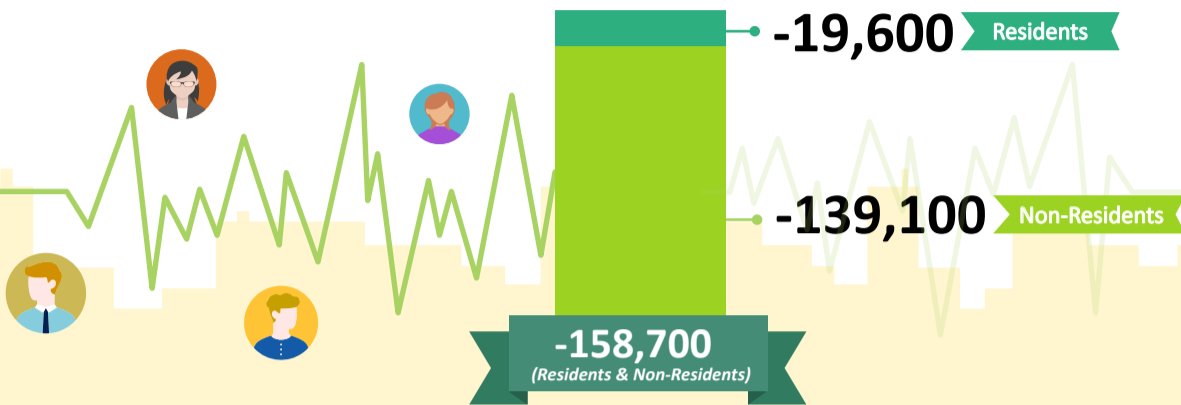

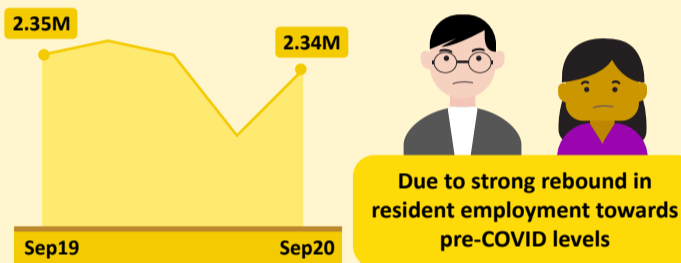
Non-residents accounted for 9 in 10 of the total employment contraction in the first three quarters of 2020



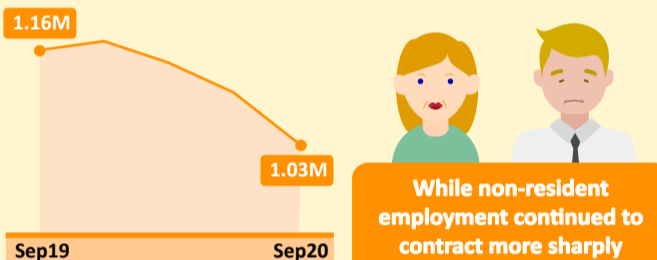
*Employment Contraction (excluding FDW) January – September 2020

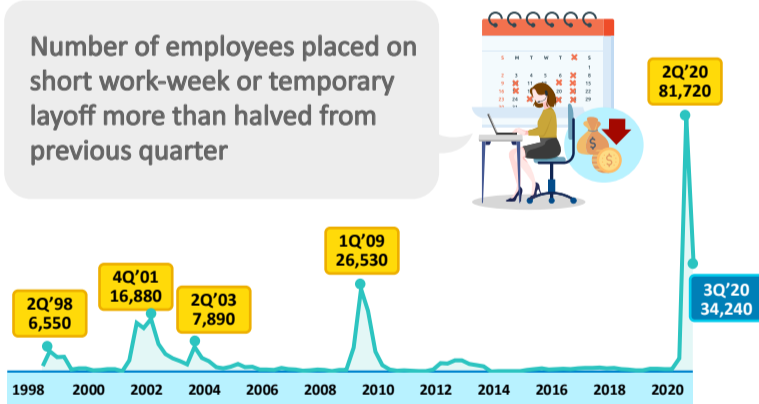

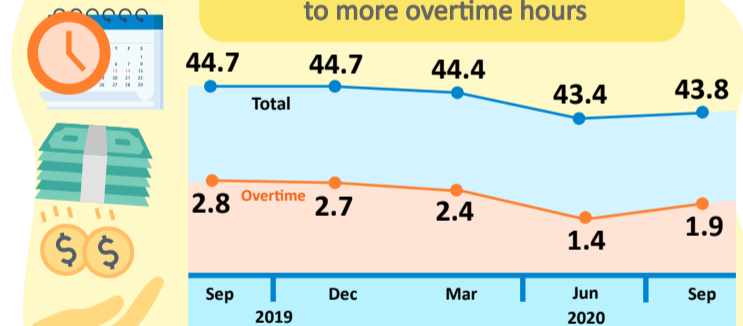


Other indicators point to a gradual pick-up in labour market activity

Number of employees placed on short work-week or temporary layoff more than halved from previous quarter

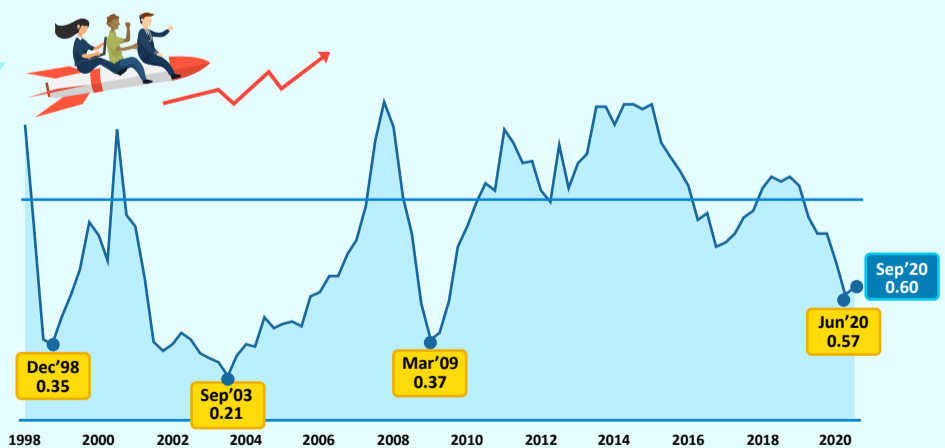


Average paid hours worked rose due to more overtime hours
