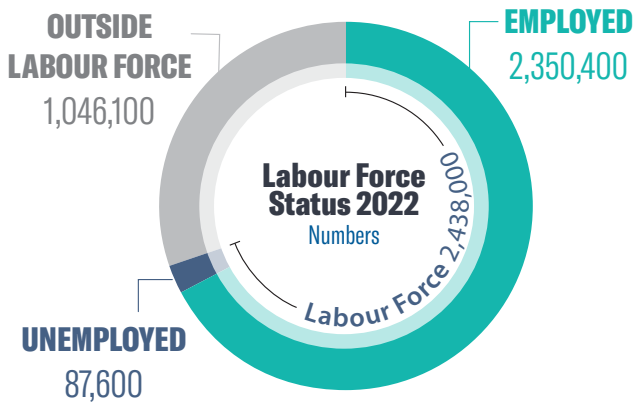


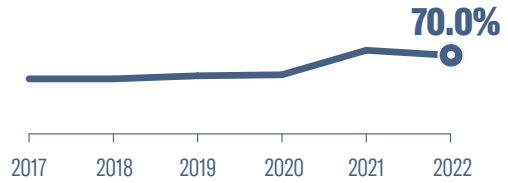

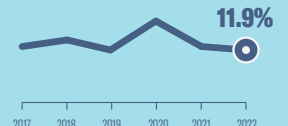
LABOUR FORCE PARTICIPATION RATE

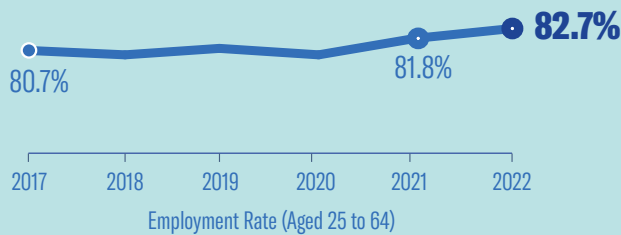
INCIDENCE OF DISCOURAGED WORKERS FELL



INCIDENCE OF POTENTIAL ENTRANTS CONTINUED TO FALL

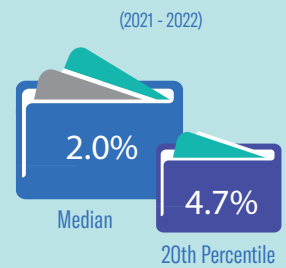
EMPLOYMENT RATE

Income including employer CPF contributions of full-time employed residents

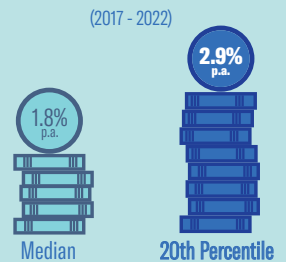


TIME-RELATED UNDER-EMPLOYMENT RATE

FELL TO AROUND PRE-COVID LEVELS

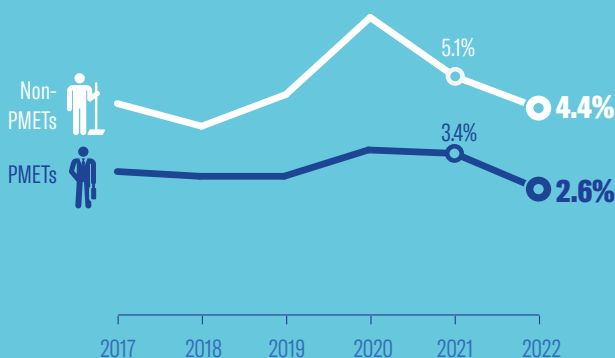


REAL INCOME GROWTH AT 20TH PERCENTILE WAS HIGHER THAN THE MEDIAN IN THE LAST 5 YEARS



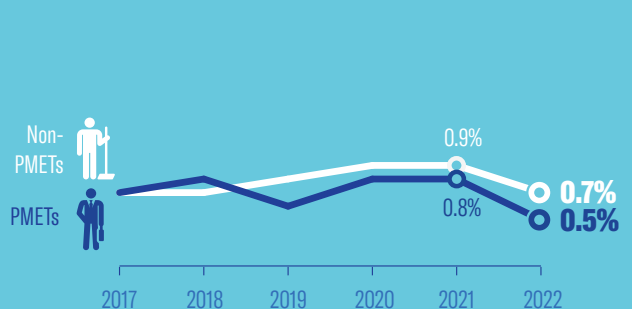
UNEMPLOYMENT RATES

SIMILARLY DECLINED TO RATES SEEN PRE-COVID



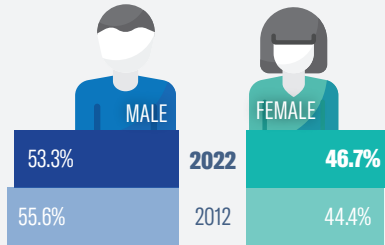

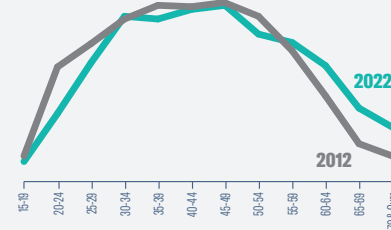
SHARE OF FEMALES ROSE

DISTRIBUTION BY SEX



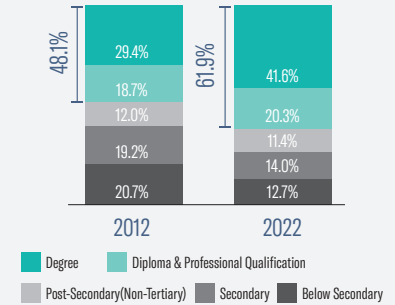
AGEING LABOUR FORCE PROFILE

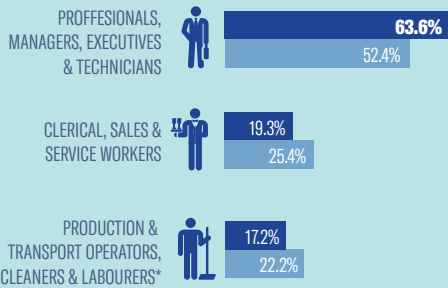
DISTRIBUTION BY HIGHEST QUALIFICATION ATTAINED

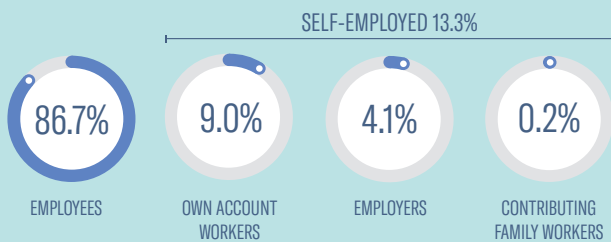

FULL-TIME VS PART-TIME EMPLOYMENT, 2022

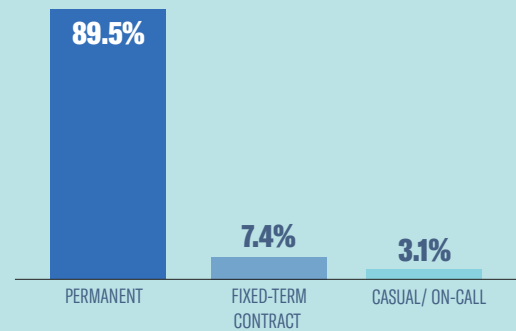

BY EMPLOYMENT STATUS, 2022

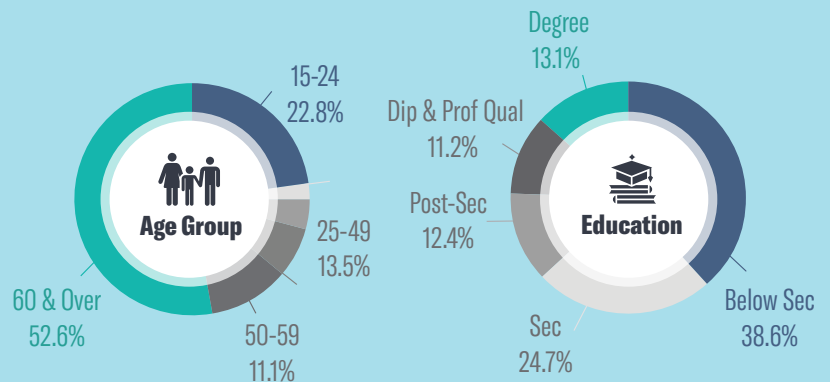


BY TYPE OF EMPLOYMENT AMONG EMPLOYEES, 2022
